





**Instructions (and see examples):**

Fold “accordion-style” (like a fan) and then cut on the dark lines.

Folded up, it’s one fish or loaf, but then it opens up into many.

Maybe copy the fish onto gray or blue paper and the bread onto tan or brown. (Or have them color them.)

I’m concerned about how well the lines will copy that close to the edge, so below are the outlines and the kids could fold the paper and then you trace the outlines and then they could cut. (I hope that made sense.)

I’m also concerned about how well the younger kids will be able to fold, so it might be best to fold them ahead of time.
